Re: Customer Service Inspection

Dear Sir or Madam,

Before continuous water service for new construction is established or when there is major material improvement, correction, or addition to the private water distribution system, Texas law requires an inspection of the private water-distribution system as a way to ensure that the water is safe to drink. This type of *customer service inspection* is required in Title 30 of the Texas Administrative Code [TAC], Subsection 290.46(j) which is administered by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ). This rule is contained in the TCEQ publication, *Rules and Regulations for Public Water Systems*, RG-195.

Inspection of the private water distribution system certifies:

Inspector signature:

- That there are no cross connections and no lead in the pipes and solder of a home/ facility that could potentially contaminate the drinking water or the public water system.
- That all exterior water faucets/hose bibbs have a HOSE BIBB VACUUM BREAKER (HVBV) installed or is designed internally within the faucet.
- That BEFORE continuous water service is granted, a cutoff/shutoff valve has been installed on the customer side of the water meter as described in the District Service Policy Rules and Regulations Section E.20.d.

The \$50.00 fee for the CSI is already included in the initial cost to have your water meter set and poses no additional cost for the initial inspection for new services.
